NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC COMMENT
MD 404 From West of Pinder Road to West of Cemetery Road



The Maryland State Highway Administration (SHA) is proposing to add two lanes to MD 404 from west of Pinder Road to west of Cemetery Road in Caroline and Queen Anne's Counties. This new roadway will extend the dualized portion of MD 404 to west of Pinder Road from the current section between Cemetery Road and Ridgely Road.
